- Soldiers haven't changed socks for five weeks.
- Soldiers haven't changed socks since Christmas.
- WE came home a moment ago. JUST
- We have just come.
- I didn't go swimming last week. FOR
- I haven't been swimming for a week.
- The thieves left and then the police arrived. BEFORE
- The thieves had left before the police arrived.
- We were late at the concert. BY
- By the time we arrived the concert had started.
- The dress is not my size. FIT
- The dress does not fit me.
- Helen is younger than me. AM
- I am not as young as Helen.
- They are building a new bridge in town. IS
- The new bridge is being built in town.
- She has written many letters. HAVE
- Many letters have been written.
- They make kids sleep for two hours in the afternoon. TO
- Kids are made to sleep for two hours in the afternoon.
- He hits her and she sometimes hits him too. OTHER
- They sometimes hit each other.
- I plan to visit you next year. AM
- I am going to visit you next year.
- I am sure she is with him now. MUST
- She must be with him now.

- We are certain they are not in Poland. CAN'T
- They can't be in Poland.
- It is forbidden to touch exhibits here. NOT
- You must not touch the exhibits here.
